Rajiv Gulati, MD, PhD, is an Interventional Cardiologist who serves as Chair of the Division of Interventional Cardiology, Director of the Cardiac Catheterization Laboratories, and Professor of Medicine at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota.

He is a highly respected leader in the field of interventional cardiology, with a clinical focus on complex coronary interventions, chronic total occlusions (CTO), peripheral arterial disease interventions, and transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR). Dr. Gulati's research is centered on improving outcomes in patients undergoing percutaneous coronary intention (PCI), with additional interests in acute coronary syndromes, vascular biology, and spontaneous coronary artery dissection (SCAD)—an area in which he is considered a leading authority.

He has authored over 200 peer-reviewed publications and contributes actively to academic discourse through his service on the editorial boards of multiple esteemed cardiology journals.

In addition to his clinical and research accomplishments, Dr. Gulati is recognized for his commitment to mentoring the next generation of interventional cardiologists and advancing the practice through innovation, evidence-based care, and global collaboration.
